MALE ALTOS/SOPRANOS

In an effort to increase vocal health awareness the WVVMA believes that allowing adolescent males to sing exclusively in the upper vocal register may inhibit the development of the lower vocal register and in some cases, cause physical damage. Therefore, the West Virginia Music Educators Association strongly recommends that male singers audition as tenor or bass singers for WVMEA All State Chorus festivals. However, if a male wishes to audition as an alto or soprano, he does so at his own risk. A consent form relieving the West Virginia Music Educators Association of liability must be signed by the student's parent or legal guardian.
